World Nuclear Exhibition : the French Nuclear Society signed a cooperation agreement with the Mongol Nuclear Society

The French Nuclear Society (SFEN) and its counterpart, the Mongolian Nuclear Society (MNS), signed a nuclear cooperation agreement on Thursday, October 16th during the World Nuclear Exhibition.

This agreement is fully in line with the cooperation between France and Mongolia in the nuclear field. This agreement will promote exchanges between the French and Mongolian nuclear professionals and contribute to promote the development nuclear energy in Mongolia.

Our two nuclear Societies will participate to common events and exchange expertise. The aim is to share knowledge about the nuclear field between the experts and professionals of each country.

Known for its mining and uranium resources, Mongolia also has 50 years of nuclear experience, particularly in research and teaching. The country wishes through the Mongolian Nuclear Society to expand its expertise in the nuclear field. Mongolia has recently developed its application in nuclear medicine and plans to build a nuclear research reactor.
