Paris, October 6th 2025

The next edition of the WNE (World Nuclear Exhibition) will take place in Paris from 4 to 6 November. Already recognised as the world's largest civil nuclear exhibition, this sixth edition is expected to be historic, bringing together 1,000 exhibitors and 25,000 visitors from more than 80 countries.

As an international showcase for the civil nuclear industry, WNE will once again unite nuclear operators and manufacturers from around the world. To date, 22 countries – representing the world's leading nuclear industry players – have confirmed their participation with national pavilions. These include Argentina, Belgium, Canada, China, Finland, France, Germany, Hungary, India, Italy, Japan, Korea, Poland, the Nordic countries (Finland, Norway, Sweden), the United States, Spain, the Czech Republic, the United Kingdom (with two pavilions), Romania, Slovenia and Ukraine.

More than ever, WNE will play a central role in shaping the future of the civil nuclear industry. In light of the challenges posed by the current climate and energy crisis, this sixth edition will centre on two key themes:

NUCLEAR TODAY AND TOMORROW

What are the key drivers of nuclear industry development? Topics will include programme acceleration, financing strategies, artificial intelligence, standardisation, fusion, and the vital task of attracting and training young talent.

ELECTRICITY & BEYOND

Uses of nuclear energy beyond electricity generation – medicine, agriculture, space, heat, hydrogen, desalination: current status and future prospects.

WNE 2025 will extend its focus beyond electricity to showcase breakthrough applications of nuclear technology across six key markets: medicine, agriculture, space, hydrogen, heat and desalination.

The Beyond Electricity Expo (BEE) will highlight the pivotal role of nuclear energy through more than 20 projects carried out worldwide.

The CEA and the IAEA are the scientific partners of this initiative, providing their support and expertise. Their involvement reinforces the mission to unlock the boundless potential of nuclear innovation and underlines the ambition to accelerate the sector's most promising ideas.

Key industry players have also chosen to back this new programme, including Calogena, NuviaTech, Orano Med, Simopt, Tractebel and Veolia.

The Pop-Up Bookshop

For the first time, WNE will offer visitors a 'pop-up bookshop'. Here, they will be able to discover and take away essential works on the civil nuclear industry, authored by some of the most influential voices in the global nuclear sector.
